

Continued Meeting 2/23/2007

The Graham County Board of Commissioners met Friday, February 23, 2007 at 4:00PM in the Office of the County Manager at 12 North Main Street, Robbinsville, NC. Present were Commissioners Lynn Cody, Raymond Williams and Eugene Trull. Commissioners Sherrill and Cable were absent. Chairman Cody called the meeting to order. This meeting was continued from the Regular Board meeting of 2/20/2007.

1. Commissioner Williams told the Board that he would check on the Ft. Hill property that needs to be bush hogged that is owned by the County. Commissioner Williams stated that the County should have a bush hog if it's not torn up and the County could do the mowing.
2. Melody Adams, County Planner, presented the Budget Amendment #8 for the Recreation Park Design. Commissioner Williams made the motion to approve this Budget Amendment. Commissioner Cody seconded this motion. Commissioner Trull voted yes. (Attached)
3. Sandra Smith told the Board that the Vehicle Maintenance building had been cleaned out and they would no longer rent it.
4. The Board agreed for permission for temporary easement/entry agreement for the Civil War Monument to be placed at the Courthouse with no cost to the County. (Attached)
5. The Board interviewed two applicants for the position of Recreation Director.
6. Commissioner Williams made the motion to hire Bobby Smith as Recreation Director. Commissioner Cody seconded this motion. Commissioner Trull voted yes. Mr. Smith's starting salary will be \$28,000.00 a year. The Board also stated that Mr. Smith will be the supervisor of Stephen Pressley and Eddie Grindstaff.
7. Commissioner Cody made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Trull seconded this motion. Commissioner Williams voted yes.
