

Public Hearing - Tuesday May 19, 2009

The Graham County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, May 19, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of a Public Hearing on submitting an application for the CDBG (Community Development Building Grant). All Board was present.

Commissioner Odom made the motion that the County Board of Commissioners serve as the Review Board for the CDBG (Community Development Building Grant). Commissioner Trull seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.

County Manager Lynn Cody along with Josh Carpenter met with Marion Hill, a representative for the grant and she explained the details concerning the grant rules.

She recommended that the county consider three stick built homes instead of modular units.

Commissioner Cable made the motion to submit the application for the CDBG grant to the state. Commissioner Trull seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.

Commissioner Trull made the motion to allow stick built homes to ensure the money stays in the county. Commissioner Cable seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.
