

Special Meeting – Monday, August 24, 2009

The Graham County Board of County Commissioners met Monday, August 24, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room of the Graham County Community Building at 196 Knight Street Robbinsville, NC for a joint meeting with Swain County Board of County Commissioners to discuss the Deal's Gap Area including sections of Hwy. 129 & Hwy.28 that Graham County provide police, fire, ambulance, rescue and sanitation services. Present were: Commissioners Bruce Snyder, Sandra Smith, Billy Cable, Gene Trull and Steve Odom. Chairman Bruce Snyder called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Snyder thanked the Swain County Board of Commissioners for coming and everyone introduced themselves. Commissioner Snyder turned the meeting over to Kevin King, Swain County Manager. Manager King stated that he had met with Manager Cody and was given a proposed dollar amount of \$115,000.00. He stated that a mutual agreement had been signed in the past and that the dollar amount that is now being paid to the county was given to them by Graham County Board of Commissioners.

The boards discussed the number of trips that are serviced by Graham County versus the number served by Swain County. The boards discussed the need for the county managers to get together to finalize a deal to present to their boards and to continue this until an agreement is made. Both boards were in agreement to this decision.

Commissioner Odom made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Cable seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.
