

Tuesday March 3, 2009

The Graham County Board of Elections met for a Continued meeting on Tuesday, March 3, 2009 at 2:00 pm at the Board of Elections office at 18 Court Street, Robbinsville, NC. Present were Chairman Colvard and Secretary Cody.

1. Chairman Colvard called the meeting to order.
2. No public comment.
3. Director Farley informed the Board that she had asked for a copy of the letter Lynn Cody received from the SBOE. He said his copy was at home, but that it was no big deal. Per Kim, the county attorney has some issues with the wording of the resolution. Secretary Cody made a motion to turn the issue over to Zeyland. Chairman Colvard seconded the motion. After requesting that County Clerk Kim Crisp be asked to join the meeting, Secretary Cody made a motion to recess until she arrives. Chairman Colvard seconded the motion. Vote unanimous. Board reconvened upon arrival of County Clerk Kim Crisp. Kim stated that there was a general misconception regarding the resolution and the staggering terms. She explained that some thought the majority of the Board of Commissioners stayed in place and only two were elected each time. She also stated that the County Attorney is researching the wording of the resolution. Chairman Colvard and Secretary Cody discussed the fact that if there does happen to be a problem with the wording of the resolution, the Board of Commissioners would revert to three members. Secretary Cody made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Colvard seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.
