

Continued Meeting 04/12/2007

The Graham County Board of Elections met Thursday, April 12, 2007 at 7:00pm in the Board of Elections office at 438 Rodney Orr Bypass, Robbinsville, NC . Present were Board Members Keith Rogers and John Carswell. This meeting is a continuation of the Regular Board meeting of 04/05/2007 meeting. Chairman Rogers called the meeting to order.

1. Chairman Rogers made the motion to approve the Agenda. Member Carswell seconded this motion. Vote was unanimous by the Board.
2. No one was present for the Public Comment session.
3. Board members sign resolution of Director's Duties that had been adopted in the March 15 meeting.
4. Disaster Recovery Plan is discussed. In case of Emergency; the East Ward will meet at the Robbinsville High School, West Ward will meet at the Graham County Library, Stecoah will Meet at the Old Stecoah School, and Tapoco will meet at Santeetlah Town Hall. Member Carswell makes a motion to approve. Chairman Rogers seconded this motion. Vote was unanimous by the board.
5. Chairman Rogers discusses Voter Stats and Director tells board that she has more cards to send out and will only need nine more registrants to meet the requested 6501. Director Farley has been in touch with Superintendent Rick Davis and it was decided that Office Asst. Glata Grindstaff will do another Registration Drive at the school when it can be set up with Principal Scott Perkins.
6. There is a discussion as to where voters can be reached, perhaps during the upcoming Holidays. Director Farley tells board that she always tries to have a booth set up around the 4th of July. Member Carswell mentions the Ramp Festival on April 28th. Member Carswell makes a motion that Director Farley and Office Asst. Glata Grindstaff be allowed to set up a booth. Chairman Rogers seconds this motion. Vote was unanimous by the Board.
7. There are no SBOE Memo's. There is a District memo dealing with a District meeting to be held in May, but there is no date as to when in May. Director will contact Director Bishop in Macon County and get back with the board. The next memo concerns the meeting in Chapel Hill on April 15th through April 17th. Chairman Rogers asks if Office Asst. will be covering office? Director says yes.
8. Chairman Rogers makes a motion to adjourn. Member Carswell seconded. Vote was unanimous.
