I. Project

Graham County Senior Center Kitchen Expansion

II. Goal

In reference to the CDBG CORONAVIRUS (CDBG-CV) Grant awarded to Graham County, NC, project # 20-V-3514 Graham County Senior Center, Graham County is soliciting Statement of Qualifications from licensed professional architect/engineering (A/E Services) firms for services related to the design and specifications required for the commercial kitchen expansion at the Graham County Senior Center. Professional design services required as part of this contract may include:

- Structural Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering
- Electrical Engineering
- Plumbing Engineering

III. Project Summary/Scope of Work

A. Graham County, a North Carolina Local Government, ("Owner") is seeking qualifications from professional A/E firms for the design of a commercial kitchen expansion including site and building plans and specs for:

- The installation of a 12'x24' prefab metal sided storage building.
- Concrete floor and slabs for approximate 22' x 10' walk in refrigerator/freezer combo
- Mechanical/Electrical and Plumbing specifications as needed for a walk-in refrigerator, freezer, fry pot and storage building.
- All plans and specifications required to take the project to bid.

Additional services include construction bid assistance, construction administration, and project close-out.

The project site is located at 185 West Fort Hill Road, Robbinsville, NC 28771 at the Graham County Senior Center.

- C. The A/E will be responsible for working with the County's Project Manager and Senior Center Director to develop plans and specifications for the Project.
- D. The selected A/E staff team must be experienced in all phases of the planning, design, and construction administration of similar public facilities; have knowledge of the regulations governing the design, construction and operation of such facilities in the State of North Carolina; and have a proven capability to effectively and efficiently produce a facility consistent with and meeting the needs and goals outlined by Graham County.
- E. The selected A/E services professional will provide the following services (not listed in order of preference):

- A conceptual plan for the commercial kitchen.
- Schematic Design.
- Cost estimating insuring design meets budget.
- Design Development.
- Preparation of Construction Documents. Preparing the final design and construction bid package in conformance with applicable regulations and requirements;
- Participating in the pre-construction conference.
- Construction administration and periodic inspection.
- Project close-out/final inspection.
- Other services customarily furnished by an A/E professional services team

IV. Selection Process & Submission

A. Process

The A/E firm will be selected by a committee in a fair and uniform manner based in part on appropriate qualifications, experience for this type of project and current workload. The Selection Committee is comprised of County staff. Upon receipt of proposals from respondents, the Selection Committee members will review the proposals in detail and will make its selection and provide written recommendations to the County Manager.

Following the County Manager's review and pursuant to section G.S. 143-64.31. of the North Carolina General Statutes, contract terms, conditions and fees will be negotiated with the selected firm based on demonstrated competence, qualifications, and evaluation criteria for the type of professional services required. In the event contract negotiations prove unsuccessful, the Selection Committee will select the next ranked firm with which to begin contract negotiations. After contract negotiations are completed, The Board of County Commissioners will be presented the contract for approval and release for design work to commence.

- 2. Please indicate whether your business is a registered Section 3 or Women-Owned/Minority HUB Business Enterprise. (10 points Max)
- 3. Project Understanding and Delivery (25 Points Max.)

Proposed workplan and schedule of activities to be performed.

4. Past-Performance and Related Experience. (25 Points Max.)

Please list three (3) projects you believe are indicative of what Graham County can expect for its expanded commercial kitchen at the Senior Center:

5. Firm Capacity and Capability (20 Points Max.)

The capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in question, including specialized services, within the period of the grant, the past record of performance of the firm with respect to such factors as control of costs, quality of work, and ability to meet schedules; description of firm's current work activities, capability of carrying out all aspects of CDBG-related activities, and firm's anticipated availability during the term of the project.

6. Familiarity with the State Building Codes and Regulations. (20 Points Max.)
