The Graham County Board of Commissioners met Monday, March 20, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. in the Graham County Community Building located at 196 Knight Street Robbinsville, NC for a public hearing on the proposed Justice/Jail Center. All the board was present. Also, present PM Jason Marino, Representative from Moseley Architects, and Interim County Manager/Clerk to Board Kim Crisp.

- Chairman Nelms called the public hearing to order and introduced the representatives from Moseley Architects. Chairman Nelms stated that the hearing was informal for those in attendance to view the three proposed sites and ask questions. Commissioner Orr stated that all options are still on the table, and they will not make their decision lightly.

Dirk Cody, Commissioner, NC Department of Transportation, stated that he would be happy to discuss the population trends that the Department of Transportation has because their predictions are that our population will decline within the next thirty years.

- 5. There were a lot of considerations being made for each site and traffic control will play a major role in determining the site.
- 6. Chairman Nelms closed the public hearing.
