Workshop Session - April 18, 2023

The Graham County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, April 18, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the Graham County Community Building located at 196 Knight Street Robbinsville, NC for their regular workshop session. All board was present.

- 1. Chairman Nelms called the meeting to order.
- 2. Chairman Nelms asks for a motion to recess the workshop session. Commissioner Orr made the motion to recess. Commissioner Eller seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.
- 3. Chairman Nelms asks for a motion to reopen the workshop session. Commissioner Orr made the motion to reopen. Commissioner Cody seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.
- 4. Chairman Nelms asks Tammy Holloway, Clerk of Superior Court to speak. Ms. Holloway stated that she needs the tile replaced in her offices, the tile is broken in several places, and this is a high traffic area. Ms. Holloway stated that some of the tile was glued down, but pieces are missing, and this is a hazard and asks that the board come by and see the condition of the floor.
- 5. Ms. Holloway stated that the awnings on the courthouse need cleaned as well as the Veteran Memorial. Ms. Holloway stated that Ronnie Williams cleaned the memorial three or four years ago and that maybe the inmates could assist with the cleaning.
- 6. Ms. Holloway stated that the carpet in the courtroom needed cleaning and asked that White's Carpet be allowed to do this work.
- 7. Ms. Holloway stated that the front of the courthouse needed to be pressure washed and the columns needed to be painted. Ms. Holloway stated that the last time the columns were painted was over thirty years ago.
- 8. Ms. Holloway stated that she would like permission to have the Urns filled with flowers at the Memorial and asks that Betty Satterfield be allowed to do this. Ms. Holloway thanked the board for the mulch each year and for the maintenance of the roses, and further stated that we have a beautiful building, and we need to take care of it.
- 9. Ms. Holloway asks that the commissioners come by her office to see the broken tile and the danger that this presents.
- 10. Ms. Holloway stated that we needed to take care of our beautiful courthouse.
- 11. Chairman Nelms asks for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Orr made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Williams seconded this motion. Vote unanimous.
